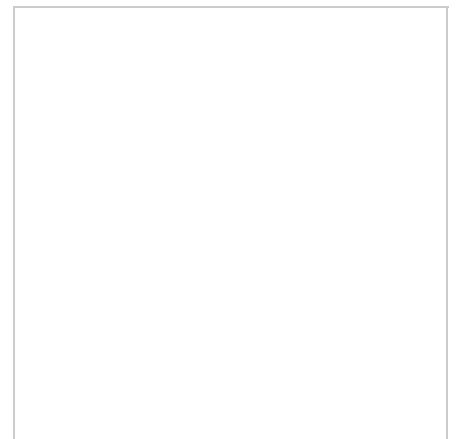

the Globe of Death and acrobats walking the sky-high Wheel of Destiny. Animal lovers will enjoy the Royal Bengal and white tigers as well as Asian and African elephants. And comedy fans can enjoy clowns, jugglers and the Keystone Kops.

Other acts include high-wire acrobats, quick-changing artists and the Rolla Bolla stars, who balance on huge spheres while navigating ramps and obstacles.

It's the first time the circus will be at the Mid-America Center, with seven shows Thursday through Feb. 22.

Unger said his favorite part of the circus is the kids' reactions. Children can ride on elephants, camels and ponies at the Circus Fun Fair, which opens an hour before performances. The fair will also have games, carnival rides and a petting zoo.

In addition to the public performances, the circus has two private performances, one for local students and the other for the area's disadvantaged. About 5,000 people from nursing homes, veterans centers and other facilities are invited.

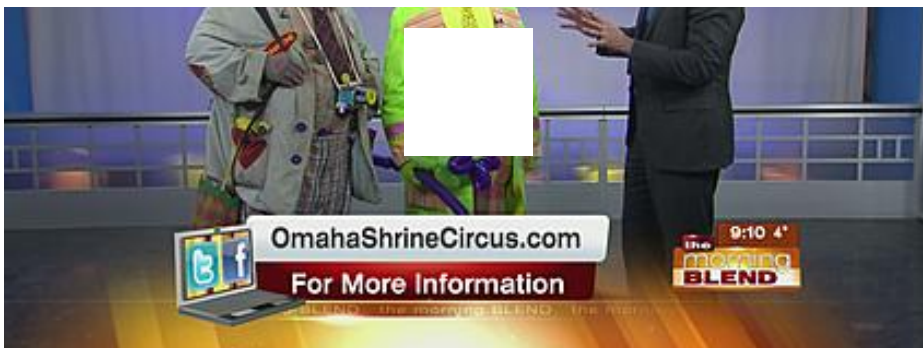
The circus will also have bike giveaway contests. Circus spokeswoman Susan Beebe said last year more than 90 bikes were given to kids. Children age 12 and under can register to win at each performance.

Beebe hopes that the free parking at the new location encourages more people to attend.

The circus is an annual event for local Shriners, a fraternal organization. Proceeds benefit the Tangier Shrine Center in Omaha.
